Award Details

One \$1,000 scholarship prize will be awarded to one student that attends the 2023 Financial Fitness Fair hosted by the Aroostook Chapter of Credit Unions. The scholarship award will be dispersed directly to the successful candidate's institution of higher education only after the successful completion of their first semester.

Eligibility

The Scholarship is available to current high school seniors who meet ALL of the criteria listed below:

- (1) Attend the Financial Fitness Fair organized by the Aroostook Chapter of Credit Unions;
- (2) Plan to enroll in a two-year or four-year college or university;
- (3) Must be a member, or have a parent that is a member, of a credit union in Aroostook County.

Selection Criteria

The Scholarship Committee will review completed applications only. Applications with missing information or incomplete sections will not be considered. The Scholarship Committee will thoroughly review each application with a focus on the applicant's written essay, and extra-curricular activities.
